A year ago we brought to you the story of Charliemagne, better known to family and friends as Charlie. At age 10, Charlie weighed only 35 pounds due to the ravages of disease brought on by severe malnutrition. Lack of food caused her autoimmune system to fail, and she became infected with Tuberculosis and osteoporosis. She became weaker and weaker, to the point that she could no longer stand up because of lack of muscle strength and tremendous pain.

The light which shines now in her eyes almost went out a year ago!

Now, after being on a RSM food program in the Diocese of San Carlos on the Island of Negros Occidental for one year, Charlie is gaining weight and growing once again. Her Tuberculosis is in remission and she can run, something she could not do since she was 7 years old. Thanks be to God!

And thanks be to you, too, for all your generous prayers and support. We are currently feeding approximately 8,000 starving children just on Charlie's island and 24,000 children overall in the Philippines weekly.

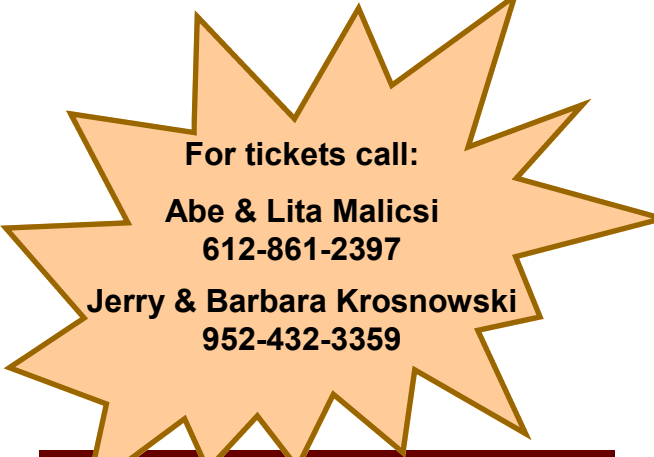
Third Annual Bigay Tulong Charity Gala — October 23
